 Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

 When I was a child, I remember learning a song from a neighbor friend—I, a Baptist, she, a Roman Catholic. “We are one in the Spirit, we are one in the Lord, (2x) and we pray that our unity may one day be restored, and they'll know we are Christians by our love, by our love, yes they'll know we are Christians by our love.” We figured there was a big difference between Baptist and Catholic. But we were singing about being united and about love being the uniting factor. Though her father wouldn't let her come to our church, and I was pretty sure God was a Baptist: we knew we shared a common faith. (Somewhat ironically, as an adult she became a Baptist, and I am a Lutheran...)

 The early church thrived as members of Christ's body cared for one another. “They take care of widows and orphans.” “They love one another and share even with strangers.” The church's strength through the years has not been in its wealth and political power, but in its compassion. If you think about it, true unity grows, not out of common interest or good feelings, but out of a commitment to act lovingly. Only those who choose to commit themselves to practicing love will be willing and able to overcome challenges in community. As John the Elder says, Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God.

 Given our mission of compassion and the fact that each of our congregations decided not to unify with CLC Filey's at this time, we as parish and congregations must still plan together for the future. Please give thought to serving on the newly forming Parish Planning Committee. This group will consider how we can continue to work together for a joyful future filled with hope and ministry. We must restructure the way we take care of the business of our churches. Many of our leaders have not had a break from council administrative responsibilities and wish to focus on ministries to which they have been called. Therefore, we must either find new leaders as per their wishes, or combine administrative efforts among the churches. These decisions are not mainly about our identities as congregations, but these decisions are about the way we do the “business” of the church. We must trust one another, work together, and allow everyone to carry out our God-given mission in the world. If we navigate these decisions and changes well, we will have a future for ministry. Please be patient with one another and with this process.

E-TITHING FOR MEMBERS OF BARREN'S - The (Barren's) council has decided to start E-Tithing for members of Barren's. This will be through PNC Bank. Members do NOT have to have an account with PNC Bank to participate in this. We hope this will help us to reach out to our home-bound members, and others who are unable to attend services regularly. This should also help us in record keeping for a number of purposes, including taxes. Anyone who is interested in E-Tithing will need to fill out an authorization form, and the bank will take care of setting things up. With E-Tithing, our members can give bi-weekly, or monthly, and there are other options as well. This tithing will come directly from the bank account of the member's choice, and will be a direct deposit into Barren's bank account. Forms will be available as soon as we have our account set up. We will be sure to announce when these are available.

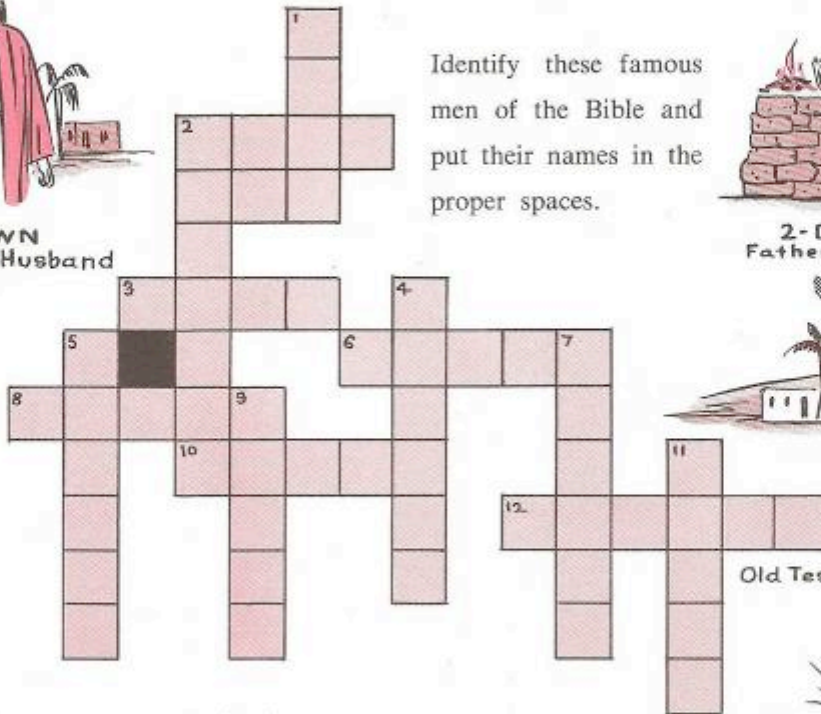

Barren's: NO-49/YES-41

Emmanuel: NO-20/YES-18

St. John's Franklin: NO-7/YES-2

Though the poll results do not favor moving ahead in unification with CLC Filey's, we need to plan for our future together and as individual congregations. There are still many conversations that will need to occur in the next coming weeks and months to begin thinking about other options.
