E-TITHING FOR MEMBERS OF BARREN'S - The (Barren's) council has decided to start E-Tithing for members of Barren's. This will be through PNC Bank. Members do NOT have to have an account with PNC Bank to participate in this. We hope this will help us to reach out to our home-bound members, and others who are unable to attend services regularly. This should also help us in record keeping for a number of purposes, including taxes. Anyone who is interested in E-Tithing will need to fill out an authorization form, and the bank will take care of setting things up. With E-Tithing, our members can give bi-weekly, or monthly, and there are other options as well. This tithing will come directly from the bank account of the member's choice, and will be a direct deposit into Barren's bank account. Forms will be available as soon as we have our account set up. We will be sure to announce when these are available.

(The rest of the current language remains the same.) This proposal will be <u>voted on at a special Congregational Meeting</u> on **May 1**.

DILLSBURG MINISTERIUM PRAYER WALK - National Day of Prayer - Thursday, May

5, 2011, 7:00 p.m. - The pastors of the Dillsburg Ministerium invite the Dillsburg community to join a prayer walk for the 60th Annual National Day of Prayer on Thursday, **May 5**, 2011. The national theme is "A Mighty Fortress is Our God" based on the verse from Psalm 91:2 which states: "I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust." The walk begins at 7:00PM at St. Paul's Lutheran Church Prayer Garden (201 South Baltimore Street). Please park in the rear parking lot of the church (which is directly behind the Prayer Garden).

Each participant will be given a candle and a candle protector for the walk. Pastors will offer a brief explanation as to why we are praying at a particular stop and then lead the group in prayer. Participants are encouraged to offer silent prayer as they are walking between stops.

The walk will progress from the St. Paul's Prayer Garden, down the hill of South Baltimore Street with stops at the public places along the way. At the square, the route will turn onto Harrisburg Street toward the Krux Student Center and the Old Monaghan Church, and then continue to New Hope Ministries on North Second Street with the final destination at the Dillsburg Senior Center. The total distance is approximately one mile.

EXPLORATORY POLL - MAY 8 - Having received an invitation to unite with Christ Lutheran Church, Filey's, we believe the best way to respond is to take a non-binding, exploratory poll on **May 8**. This is NOT a final vote for unification. Rather you will be asked to indicate on a piece of paper your opinion in one of two ways: "Yes, I support forming a new congregation with CLC Filey's, and believe we should form a multi-congregational task force to work on the proper documentation." or "No, I do not support forming a new congregation with CLC Filey's and think we should make other plans for the future." There will also be space for your comments.

For those of you who will not be able to attend worship on May 8th, and would like to express your opinion, please contact one of your pastors prior to May 7th so that your opinions can be included with that of your congregation. We will ask that anyone who will be absent from church and would like to participate in the poll please include your name and congregation with your opinion, so that we can keep track of those who have already participated in the poll. Otherwise, names will not be required on the May 8th poll.

We believe that taking a poll will be the best way to discover how each congregation feels about the matter of unification with CLC Filey's and will help us to know what steps to take next. It seems to be in the best interest of all congregations to look for at least an approval rate of 2/3rds (of the total poll of each congregation) before making further plans. The poll, though non-binding, is the only measure of intention which we have to know which path to take into the future.

Barren's Council Meeting Minutes - Summary <u>April 19, 2011 at Barren's</u>


